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A_i has a $\mathbb{Z}$ -homomorphism $\varphi_i: D_{\text{max}}(A_i) \rightarrow D_{\text{max}}(C_{\text{max}}(A_i))$, $\varphi_i(d) = d$, for $d \in D_{\text{max}}(A_i)$. The $C_{\text{max}}(A_i)$ -homomorphism $\varphi_i: D_{\text{max}}(A_i) \rightarrow D_{\text{max}}(C_{\text{max}}(A_i))$ is extended to a $\mathbb{Z}$ -homomorphism $D_{\text{max}}(A_i) \otimes_{\mathbb{Z}} D_{\text{max}}(A_j) \rightarrow D_{\text{max}}(A_i) \otimes_{\mathbb{Z}} D_{\text{max}}(A_j)$, $\varphi_i \otimes 1$. Then, A_i and A_j are C_{max} -isomorphic.
