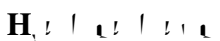

As a result of the termination of the Framework Agreement, the Company intends to apply the proceeds in the said amount of RMB62,400,000 (approximately HK\$71,305,000) for prepayment of polysilicon materials in order to secure stable source of such materials.
